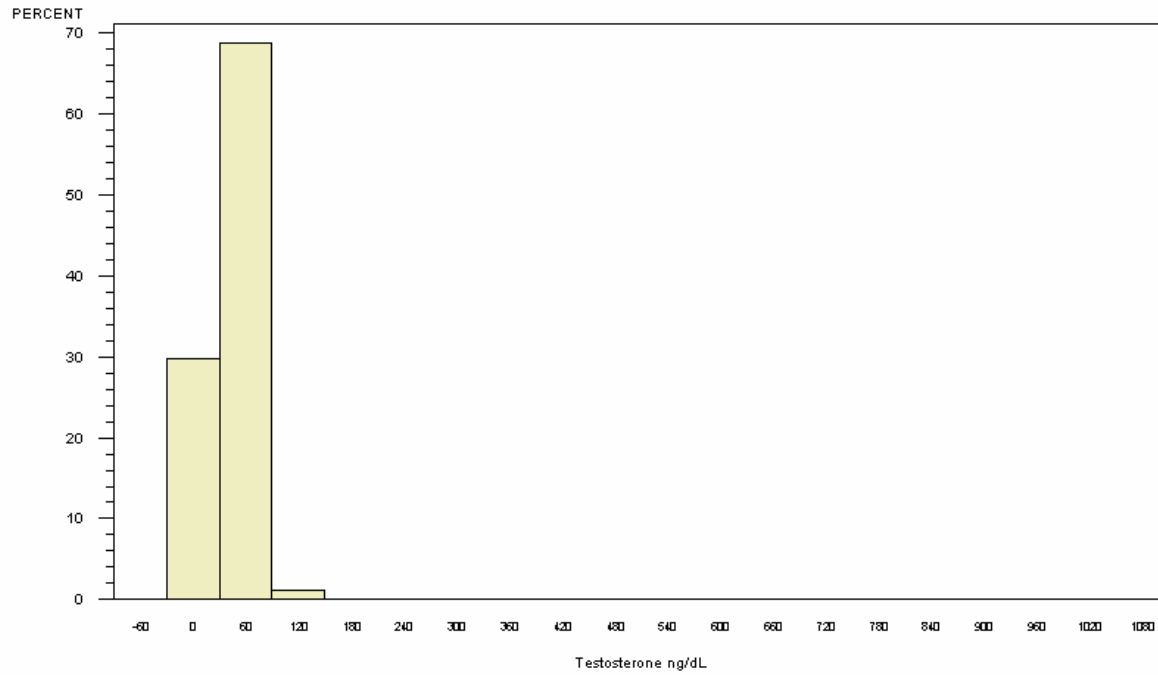

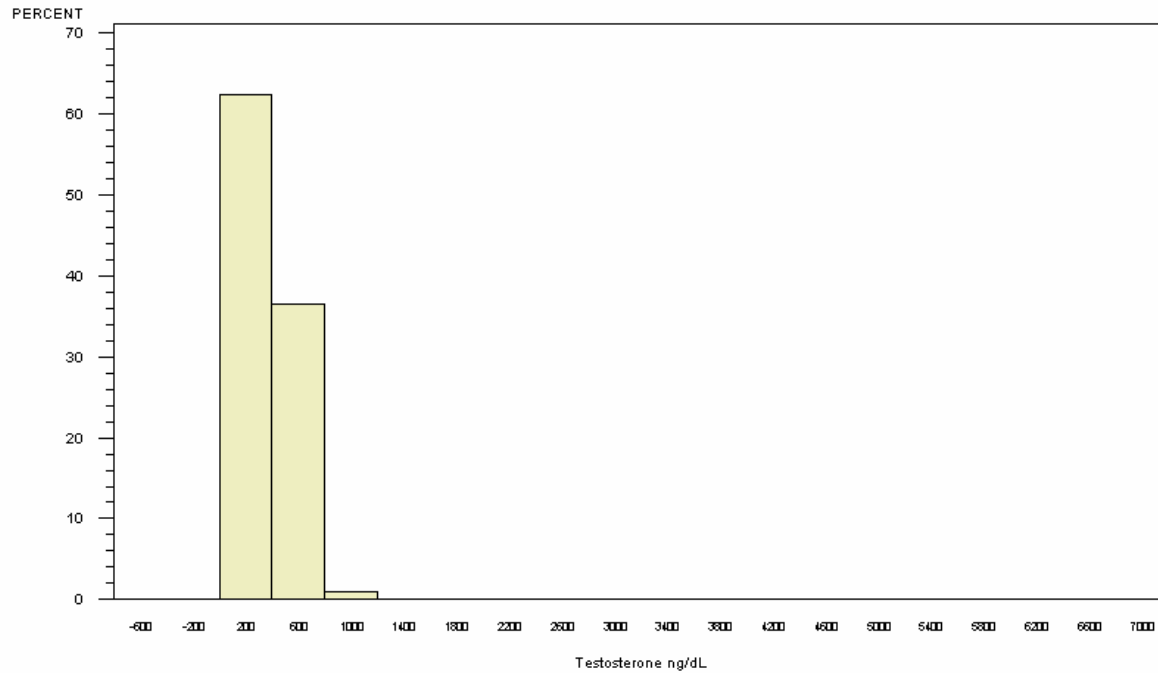

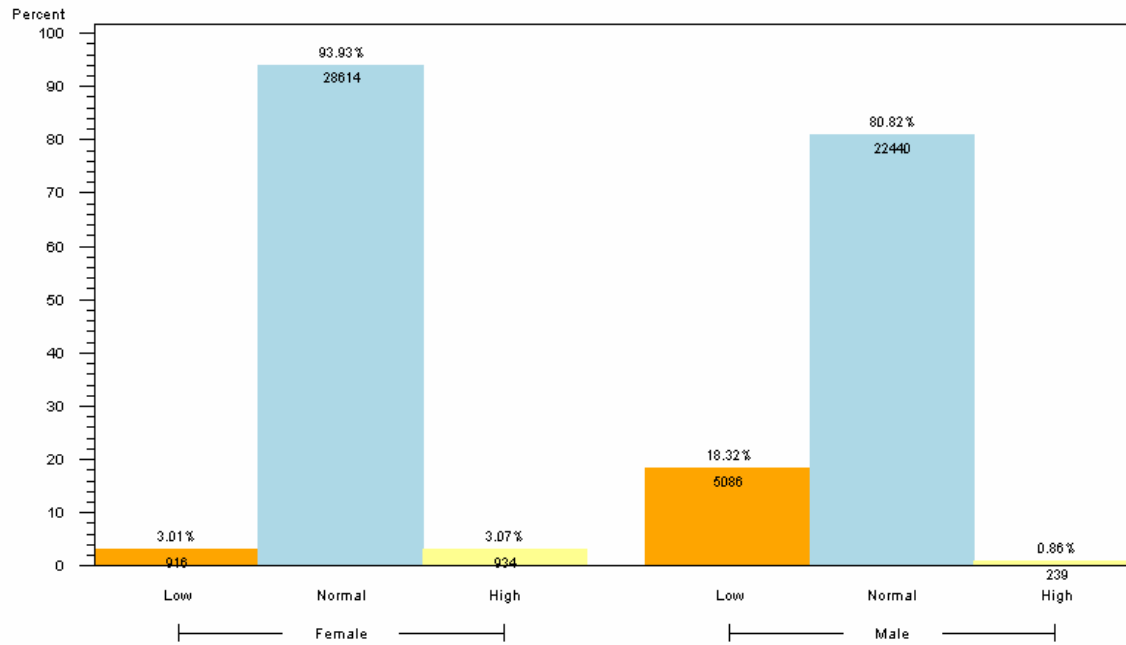

Reader's Guide to Understanding This Information:

Approximately 90% of females and 80% of males >15 years of age had normal levels of serum testosterone. A higher proportion of males compared to females had lower than expected levels of testosterone.
