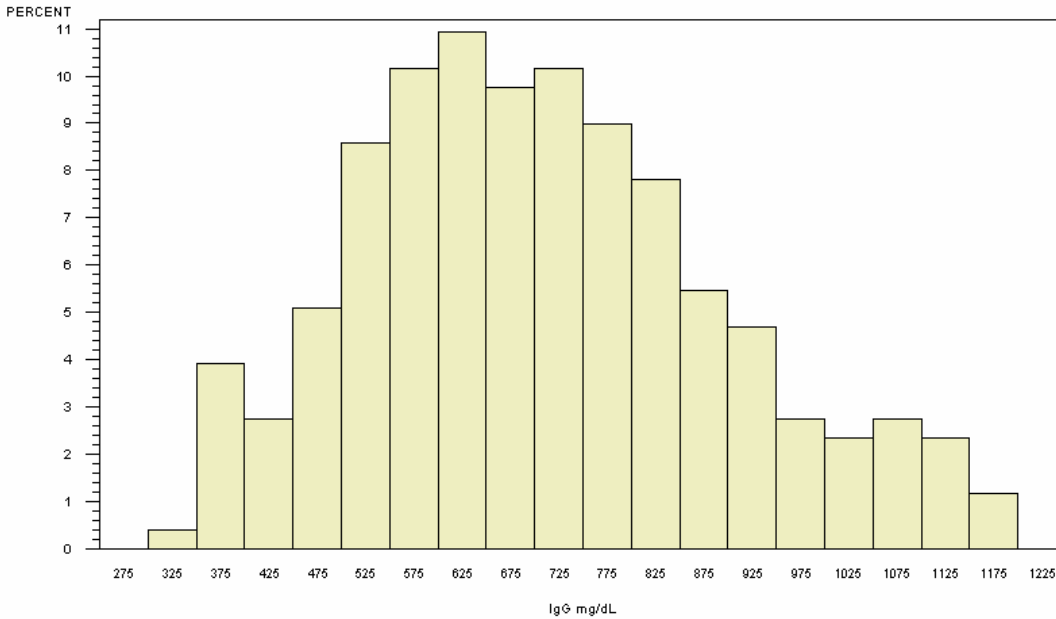

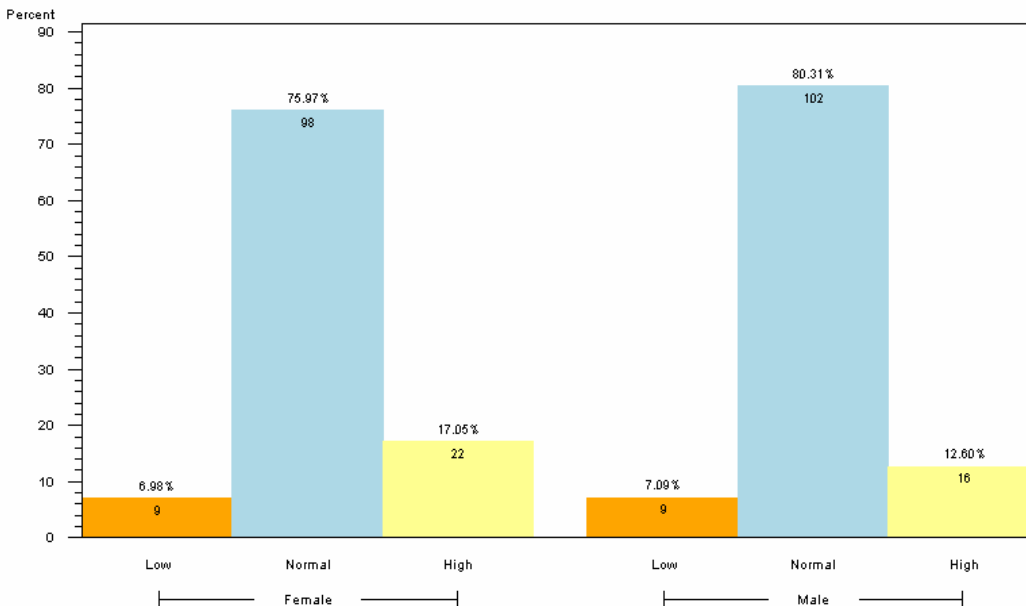

Reader's Guide to Understanding This Information:

Approximately 75% of girls and 80% of boys 1-3 years of age had IgG levels within the expected range. A slightly higher proportion of girls compared to boys had elevated levels of IgG. Similar proportions of girls and boys had lower than expected levels of IgG.
