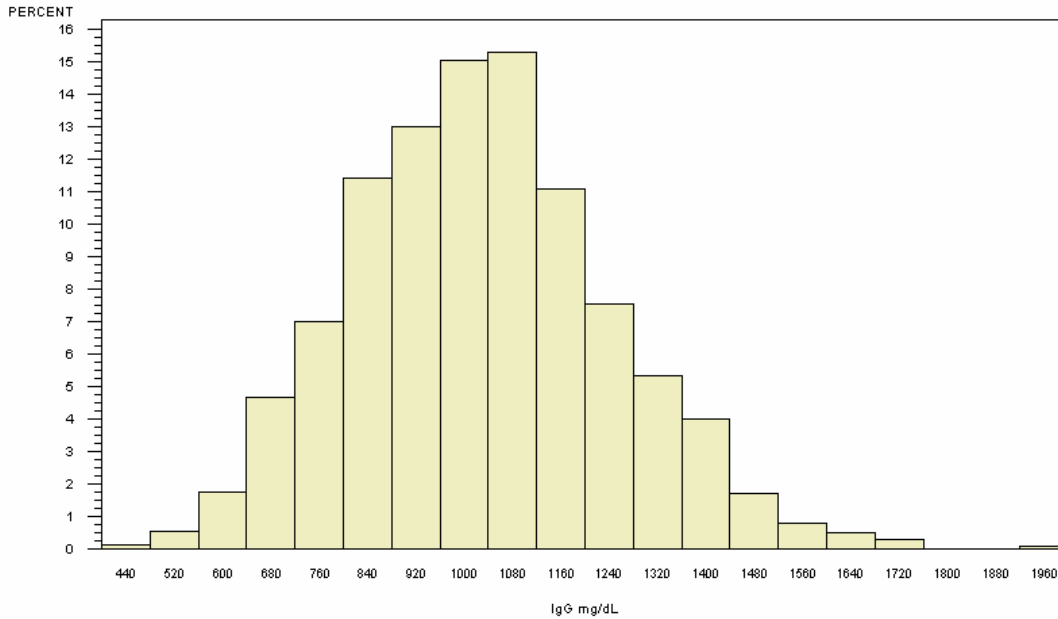

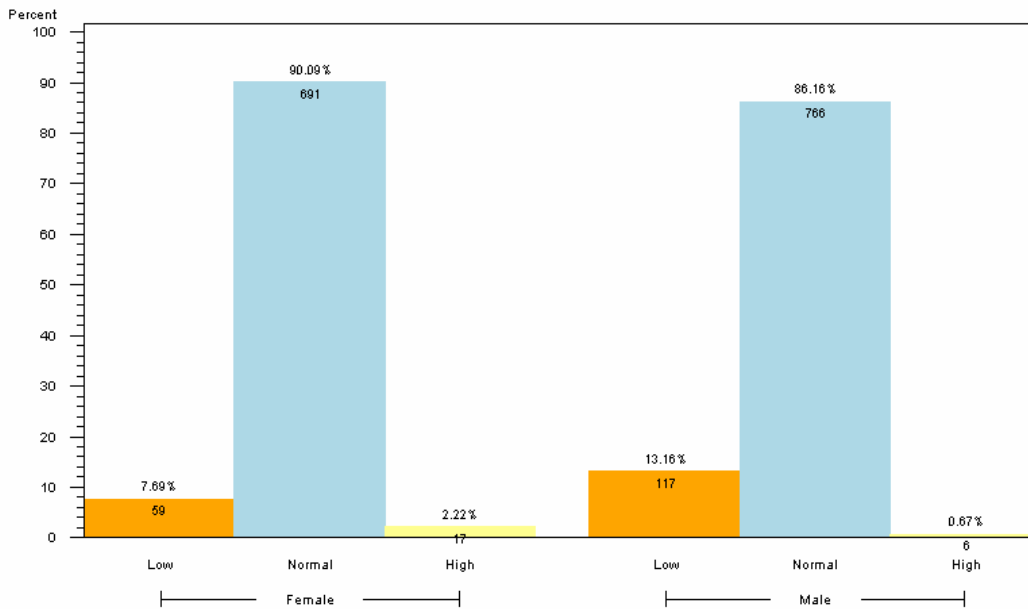

Approximately 90% of children 12-13 years of age had normal levels of IgG. A slightly higher proportion of boys compared to girls had depressed levels of IgG.
