
EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR RADIATION ACCIDENTS

Minor Spills

- 1) **NOTIFY** people in the area that a spill has occurred.
- 2) **CONTAIN THE SPILL.** Cover the spill with absorbent paper and tape off area.
- 3) **CLEAN UP.** Use disposable gloves and remote handling tongs. Dispose of absorbent material in radioactive waste container.
- 4) **SURVEY** the area with Geiger Meter or use damp filter paper and scintillator. Also, survey hands, feet and clothes.
- 5) **REPORT INCIDENT** to the Radiation Safety Office.
- 6) **DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS** are provided in <u>Section 13</u> of the Radiation Safety Manual.



Major Spills

- 1) **CLEAR THE ROOM** of all people not involved in the spill.
- 2) **CONTAIN THE SPILL.** Cover the spill with absorbent paper and use shielding to decrease contamination exposure.
- 3) **SECURE THE ROOM** to prevent entry until Radiation Safety arrives.
- 4) **REPORT** incident immediately to **RADIATION SAFETY.**
- 5) **DECONTAMINATION** procedures will be administered by Radiation Safety.
- 6) **DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS** are provided in <u>Section 13</u> of the Radiation Safety Manual.
